TOURNAMENT DETAILS:

Organized by: Vienna Floorball Association

Categories:

U13: Kids male resp. mixed, 1996 and younger, minimum of 3, maximum of 8 teams

U15: Juniors male resp. mixed, 1994 and younger, minimum of 3, maximum of 8 teams

Prizes:

The winners in both categories as well as 2nd and 3rd teams will be awarded a cup of the Vienna Floorball Association.

Each team will get a certification of the tournament.

Rules:

The tournament will be played according to the valid SUHV (Swiss Unihockey Federation) rules with the following exceptions: There will be no team time-out.

Game System:

Game system will be specified after the end of registration.

It depends on the number of the participants.

Matches: on small field, 3 players with goalie

Referees:

The matches will be directed by referees from Austria.

Playing time:

Playing time is 2*10 minutes.

The playing time will not be measured effectively.

Game schedule:

The area is open from 9 a.m.

End of the tournament latest 6 p.m.

Participation fee:

EUR 50,-/team. Fees (bank fees not included) must be transferred till October 1st, 2009.

Insurance:

The teams are not insured by the organizer!

PLEASE NOTE

Every player is taking part in the tournament at his own risk. The participants are not insured by the organiser. Each player is only allowed to play for one team (no switching between U13 and U15). If you play for a different club than your home club, your home club must be informed about your participation and accept it.

The players are not allowed to wear shoes which can lose colours to the floor.

The match protocol must be filled in block letters and handed over the secretariat minimum 15 minutes before the match.

The teams have to be in time for the matches. Every team has to be ready minimum 15 minutes before the official beginning of the match in case of any differences in the official match schedule.

There wont be any opportunity to warm up on the floorball ground.

The number of changing rooms is limited and therefore no team can be given a changing room for the whole tournament. There are lockers in the changing rooms but we recommend to take all belongings into the playing halls.

The organisers can not be taken responsible for any loss of personal belongings during the tournament.
